

MI Employers Will Lose Full FUTA Credit

The crisis in the automobile industry has left Michigan with the highest unemployment rate in the U.S. (15.2% is the latest figure from June). The Unemployment Insurance Agency (UIA) of the Michigan Department of Energy, Labor, and Economic Growth has announced that Michigan will not be able to repay outstanding loans for its unemployment insurance (UI) program by the November 10, 2009 deadline. This means that the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA) rate for Michigan employers will increase to 1.1% from 0.8%. The additional FUTA taxes are due by the due date of federal Form 940, Employer's Annual Federal Unemployment (FUTA) Tax Return, which must be filed by February 1, 2010 [UIA, Fact Sheet No. 126, June 2009].

Federal Form 940 To Be Revised

Sometime after November 10 of each year, the credit reductions for that year are announced by the IRS and are included on Form 940 (Part 1, Line 6) so employers in the affected states can figure the amount of their credit reduction. Thus, the IRS will make the official determination of the credit reduction states for 2009 sometime after November 10, 2009.

Michigan SMB users need to modify their FUTA calculation and may need to enter hand computed payroll records to adjust for employees no longer employed with earnings in 2009. Contact our office should you need assistance.

One of the employees does not want any federal income taxes withheld from his check. How do I do this in Sage Master Builder payroll module?

After you trial compute, locate the payroll record at menu 5-2-2. Click on the calculation tab. Look for the calc "Federal Income Tax" with the Calc Type "1-Deduct from Employee" Delete the amount and enter a Y in the Override column and save. Trial compute again to be sure you have the desired results.

When I try to print every time I get a message that states, "The default drive is not available. Setting to application drive." How can I fix this?

This is just a simple issue of a default setting. Perform the following:

1. Open the Report Printing screen.
2. From the Drive menu, select the desired drive.
3. From the Defaults menu, select Save Default Drive.
