SMB Version 14 Release

Sage began shipping Sage Master Builder Version 14 the third week of August and our phones began ringing. Most of the calls we received were due to licensing issues.

Our first question to each of these calls was did you read the Installation Guide on the CD. Not one of the users on each of the calls had read it. We would just like to share with you the very first instruction in the guide, **"Read This Before You Install".**

This install is different that the typical SMB tax update. To keep up with the ever-changing technology, there program source code has been changed to open the doors for the new features you will find in this version and for future versions to come.

Sage Master Builder Version 14 also contains a new licensing system, which is installed to each computer when you install the program. All the computers on your network must be running version 14 licensing for workstations to be able to obtain a license use. The guide says "When upgrading, you should install the upgrade to the license server computer first." We say, "You must install to the license server first."

Nearly all of the support calls we received, the licensing server was not installed first.. These companies were at a standstill until we could accommodate them. Most involved a complete uninstall and modifications in the system registry. So, if you're not one to read instructions, please at least read the very first instruction in the Installation and License Administration Guide found on your Sage Master Builder Version 14 CD.

Discovered the form on the server drive had somehow became corrupted. Copied statement from the local drive to the server drive.

Why can't one of our users print a job report? She is getting a security access error.

We discovered the field properties were set and the user's group did not have permission to see any contract amounts.

I need to reissue a paycheck. Do I just copy, void, and paste?

No. Simply change the check number to 0000 and return to the print menu and reprint. SMB looks for the 0000 check number on payroll records for checks to be printed. Don't forget to enter the original check into the GL as a manually voided check with no dollar amount for your bank reconciliation and paper trail.
